Purification Sacrifice	Restored relationship with God due to effects of sin; also known as sin offering (Lev 4:1-5:13, 6:24-30); Sin- bearer - <u>1 Peter 2:24</u>			
Restitution Sacrifice	Violation of the covenant by sinning against God or others is forgiven through confession, restitution, and sacrifice; also known as guilt offering (<i>Lev 5:14-6:7; 7:1-10</i>); Guilt Offering - <i>Isaiah 53:10</i>
